

CEA CONEXPO PREVIEW



The show's organisers are expecting more than 130,000 visitors, of which 42% will be contractors. There should be plenty for them to see, as the North American market's continued recovery has spurred more than 2,400 exhibitors to book space in the Convention Centre's numerous halls and external lots.

A comprehensive education programme will run alongside the show, with more than 110 sessions concerning industry trends and issues, management and applied technologies. Topics will include aggregates, asphalt, business management best practise, concrete, cranes, earthmoving, equipment management and maintenance, recycling, safety and workforce development.

"Attendees will find the newest products and technologies and technical experts ready to discuss product features and applications. In the space of a few days, in one place, visitors can examine and compare the best of what our industries have to offer," says Megan Tanel, show director and Association of Equipment Manufacturers (AEM) vice president for exhibitions and events.

Though a major international exhibition, the domestic North American market will of course be the main driver for a successful show this year, with continued steady recovery being felt in many sectors. However, while that growth has not been quite as rapid as many predicted at this time last year, market demand is expected to be strong. Indeed Conexpo itself will grow this year, with a record amount of show space being booked.

"The United States is still experiencing a pattern of slow growth," says the AEM's Dennis Slater.

"We were more optimistic early in 2013 for much stronger growth overall, but we anticipate for 2014 that Conexpo-Con/Agg in March will once again be a great momentum builder for our industry.

"Continued uncertainty in the marketplace caused by federal government gridlock has hurt business results and dampened business confidence. Key global markets remain sluggish.

"However with many companies delaying a buy decision, the uncertainty has actually helped rental company growth in utilization and rates.

"The energy market also continues its growth, with fracking and natural gas, while residential housing is still moving in a positive direction."

Mike Osenga, publisher of industry titles Diesel Progress North America and Diesel Progress International, agrees.

"Depending on the specific equipment segment, the construction markets in North America are expected to be flat to slightly up in 2014.

"The first part of the year might be the better half, as the industry usually sees a Conexpo-Con/Agg "bump" in sales. Often Conexpo-Con/Agg provides a first quarter increase, followed by a slower second quarter.

"It's hard to find any truly booming bright spot in the North America construction equipment markets right now," says Mr Osenga.

"But, other than mining, there don't appear to be many severely depressed markets either."

Among the many show stands, there will be a number of international pavilions, from the UK, China, Italy, Taiwan, Germany, Ireland and Korea. The CEA will once again organise and run the highly successful UK Pavilion at Conexpo.



UK Trade & Investment

The UK Pavilion provides 20 UK companies with a high profile presence at the show, where smaller individual stands can often be lost in the many exhibition halls. However it also provides a central focus for other UK companies, CEA members and visitors to meet and do business throughout the show.

The CEA is once again working closely with UKTI on the Conexpo Pavilion and exporting companies should always make contact with UKTI to see what assistance might be available.

"The UKTI USA team provides a range of bespoke offerings to UK companies to assist with market entry, including a chargeable tailored consultancy service (OMIS - Overseas Market Introduction Service)," says Richard Colley, vice consul at UKTI Chicago with a focus on supporting trade in Advanced Engineering and Manufacturing sectors across the Midwest region. Additionally, he leads UKTI's US activities across the construction equipment and commercial vehicle sectors.

"This can include market information (research/competitors), contacts (agents/distributors/partners) and relevant events (product launch/workshops)," he says.




